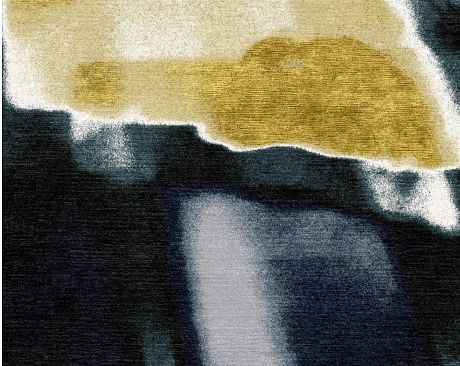


## Selfie
