DESCRIPTION

A helictite is a cave formation that defies gravity, changing its axis from the vertical to grow in any direction. Where STALACTITE hangs, HELICTITE sits: the same crystalline language brought to tabletop scale. Warm light passes through quartz at the most intimate distance, each piece carrying the geological memory of formations that twist, branch, and spiral in the darkness underground.
