Fiddlehead Cantilever

DESCRIPTION

Jason Miller's Fiddlehead is a series of lamps, which derives its name from sprouting ferns. One end of Fiddlehead's long, furling arm gently balances a hand-blown glass globe; the other uses the wall or ceiling as a counterbalance.

FINISHES: Blackened steel, oil-rubbed bronze, polished nickel, brushed brass

GLASS: Smoke, clear, cream

CANOPY: 5-inch round in matching metal finish
