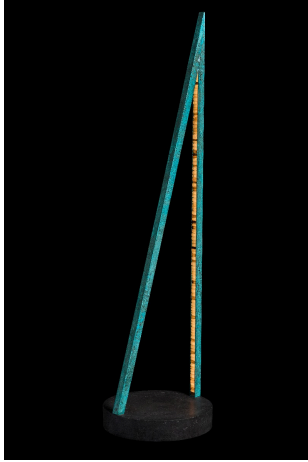

DESCRIPTION

The alchemical symbol for fire is a triangle, a point rising like a flame. Channeling the soaring energy of the triangle, ARCHIMEDES embodies fire's essence: a triangular brass structure protruding from a composite cement base. THALASSA introduces a verdigris finish alive with blue-green hues, named for the primordial goddess of the sea. The patina recalls copper's transformation in salt air: the memory of ocean made material.
