3 Connect the 24V DC POWER CABLE from the PENDANT to supplied POWER SUPPLY UNIT. Refer to supplied WIRING DIAGRAM \rightarrow






Adjust the level of the fixture using the adjustable CABLE GLIDERS. The lengths of the SUSPENSION WIRES can be adjusted to be lower by taking the weight off the suspension wire, and pushing on the spring loaded NIPPLE on the CABLE GLIDER to release.

Remember to always support the fixture during this process. Once settled on the level of the fixture, remove any remaining protective packaging.

6 Unpack the MAGNETISED CRYSTALS straight from the box onto the MAGNETIC SURFACE of the ring. Begin placing them from any chosen SUSPENSION WIRE.






- · Rotate magnetised crystals until the magnet makes full contact with magnetic surface.
 - Pack the crystals onto the ring tightly, without overlapping. Cover as much visible LED as possible.
 - If crystal selection does not fit as desired, there are spare crystals to use in place of others.



Some MAGNETS are not central to the crystal. Rotate the crystal so each MAGNET sits closest to the
 RING. It is normal if a small portion of the crystal is hanging over the edge of the ring.



Weight and arrangement of crystals may cause the pendant to become unbalanced. Check that the pendant is still level, and re-adjust if necessary, following instructions from Step. 5
