Under no circumstances shall Studio Paolo Ferrari be liable for any incidental, consequential, or other damage resulting from negligence, misuse, mishandling, or exposure of any chemicals used in connection with maintenance. Information relating to chemicals/cleaning solvents, environmental use, and human exposure should be reviewed with appropriate suppliers. Wood Surface Care Instructions:

- The finish applied to the wood surface is a durable and institutional grade finish. With proper care it will last a lifetime.
- Dust regularly with a clean, dry, or damp non-abrasive cloth
- Clean up any spills immediately with a non abrasive cloth
- Spot clean with mild soap and water as required. Apply with a cloth, and avoid wetting the surface for extensive periods.
- Avoid cleaning and treating with wood oils or waxes, and harsh detergents, chemical cleaners, or solvents.
- Avoid Windex (ammonia), vinegar, and bleach.

Metal Care Instructions:

- The finish applied to the metal surfaces is a durable and institutional grade finish. With proper care it will last a lifetime.
- Dust with clean, dry, or damp non-abrasive cloth.
- Spot clean with mild soap and water as required. Apply with cloth, and avoid wetting for extensive periods.
- Avoid cleaning and treating with oils, waxes, harsh detergents, chemical cleaners, or solvents.
- Avoid Windex (ammonia), vinegar, and bleach.

Studio Paolo Ferrari Stone Surface Care Instructions:

- The stone surface is honed to a polish, and with proper care it will last a lifetime.
- Dust with a clean, dry, or damp non-abrasive cloth
- Spot clean with mild soap and water as required. Apply with a cloth, and avoid wetting the surface for extensive periods.
- Avoid cleaning and treating with oils, waxes, harsh detergents, chemical cleaners, or solvents
- Avoid vinegar and Windex (ammonia) these substances will eat into the marble and dull the stone.

Ame Natural Textile and Fringe Care Instructions

- For the Maharam Pebble Wool Fabric care, follow the manufacturers recommended care instructions
- The Handwoven textile on the back of the Ame Lounge is a functional artwork, and the fabric needs special and delicate care in regards to cleaning and maintenance.
- For the fringe, gently shake it to dust regularly
- A vacuum cleaner attachment especially for fabric may also be used on a
 delicate setting to clean the flatwoven textile and fringe. To do this, hold
 some fringes together while carefully using the vacuum cleaner on low
 setting. You can also do this to remove dust from the flat woven area.
- If there is a stain in the flat woven area, use gentle detergent in that section and gently blot with a soft brush or cloth, and blot to dry. Avoid rubbing the textile. For stains in the fringe, it is possible to use gentle detergent, rub gently, and rinse that section. It is possible that the fringe will wrinkle when it dries out after washing. If that happens, gently stretch the fringe and iron on a delicate setting to straighten the fringe.

General Fabric Care Instructions:

- Refer to specified fabric manufacturer's maintenance, care and cleaning instructions and seek professional cleaning services when applicable, before following any of the suggested instructions below.
- Vacuum regularly using the proper attachment to avoid pilling.
- Treat stains promptly. The longer a stain remains on the textile, the more difficult it will be to remove. A professional furniture cleaning service is highly recommended.
- Always pre-test any cleaning method in an inconspicuous area.
- Several light applications of a cleaning agent are less harmful than a single concentrated application. Repeat stain treatment several times if necessary.

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- Never use heat to clean textiles. Heat can set stains.
- Do not use agents containing bleach. These agents my cause discoloration over time.
- Do not over saturate the textile or let water pool in seams.
- Soak up any excess moisture immediately.
- For oil and water-based stains, use a clean, soft, white cloth, a natural sponge, or a nylon, soft-bristle brush with a water-free dry cleaning solvent. Brush the stain with light, quick strokes. Avoid a scrubbing motion and work from the edge of the stain toward the center.
- For insoluble stains (e.g. chewing gum, candle wax, etc.), Use a plastic bag filled with ice to rub the stain until the substance becomes brittle. Use a clean, dull, flat knife to gently remove the substance.
- Extra care should be taken when cleaning dark colors to avoid creating light marks that can be caused by color transfer.
- Avoid excess rubbing to prevent discoloration and damage to the face of the material.
